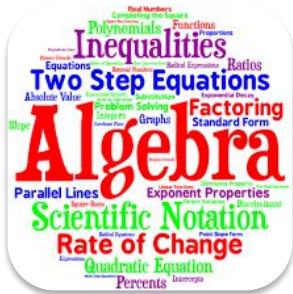

Typical math progression starting freshman year



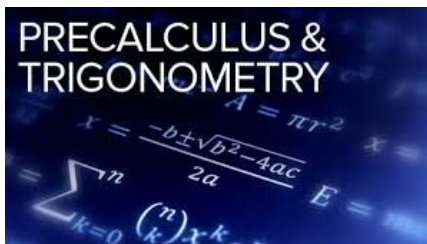


